Bimini Big Game Club Joins Bimini Tourist Advisory Board in Several Community Improvement Projects

ALICE TOWN, BIMINI—SEPTEMBER 23, 2011— Management at the historic Big Game Club, a Guy Harvey Outpost Resort & Marina has rolled up its sleeves and pitched in with manpower and money to work with the Bimini Tourist Advisory Board (BTAB) to kick off a series of community improvement programs.

In it's first effort, staff from the Big Game Club, which is located on the main navigation channel in Bimini Bay, launched a clean-up campaign at the Bimini Memorial site located next to the resort. Neglected and overgrown with weeds and bushes, the site was nearly invisible to those passing by.

"We thought it was a shame to see it in that kind of condition as the memorial was established to recognize citizens, especially those who served with honor in WWI and II," said Michael Weber, Bimini Big Game Club General Manager.

Weber said many locals, government officials and police took note of his cleanup crew's efforts, "honking their horns in support" and "even taking time to stop and thank us for caring about the island's heritage."

Weber said a second community project will involve Porgy Bay Park, a 100' x 200' foot empty lot that on October 1st will be transformed into a functioning park for families and their young children.

"The BTAB, community members and the team from the Big Game Club will spend that day building picnic tables and benches as well as adding some playground type of equipment and a basketball hoop," he added.

A third project, which is still being finalized, will involve helping to establish a horticultural/agricultural garden area for local high school students to plant and study as a class project on the grounds of the Big Game Club. Once complete, guests will get to see a variety of native plants such as Banana trees, Papaya, Sapodilly, Guinep, Guava and Pineapple being grown right at the resort.

"The Big Game Club has been part of this wonderful community since the late 1940's and management realizes its our obligation to participate in making this not only a world class destination for our guests, but a great place to live and raise families as well," Weber concluded.

Bonefish Bimini, headed by artist, conservationist and fly fishing personality, Vaughn Cochran, works with the island's elite bonefishing guides and is quickly restoring awareness of Bimini's legendary "Big Bones".

Sportfishing charters operations have been established at the Club, with the recent arrival of record setting Captain Billy Black, a fixture on the Bahamas offshore fishing circuit.

The Big Game Club, which is located on the main navigation channel in Bimini Bay, currently features a 51-room resort and a 75-slip marina capable of accommodating boats up to 145 feet in length. A full service fuel dock will be operational by Spring 2012.

Guestrooms and suites have been fully renovated, as with the new Bimini Big Game Bar & Grill, and completion of the Hemingway Lounge and Gulfstream conference center. The Club also offers the Guy Harvey Outfitter Shop, for the best in sportswear, gifts and accessories.
